RULES: This regatta will be governed by the **Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 edition**

ELIGIBILITY: All boats with a 2009 PHRF- ELI rating certificate and one design keelboats racing in their one design division are eligible. This race will not count toward any Breakwater or ELIYA series.

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00. The only deduction will be \$5.00 if a member of US Sailing. Entries will be complete with a valid 2009 ELI-PHRF certificate, a check made out to Breakwater Yacht Club, and a completed race entry form with a signed waiver submitted to Joan Worthing, 104 S. Magee St., Southampton, New York 11968 (631-287-3205) by Thursday, Oct. 22, 2009 at 6:00pm. Last minute checks will be accepted prior to the first gun as long as you have declared your intention to race by Friday at 6:00 pm by emailing or faxing your race entry form & PHRF certificate to Joan at JoanWorthing@optonline.net or 702-977-7303. (If Joan already has your current 2009 ELI-PHRF, then you do not have to send another copy.)

START: In Sag Harbor-The start is between the RC boat (flying RC flag and yellow pennant) and a set mark at the most leeward point of Shelter Island Sound

START TIME: The first gun (warning for first division to start) will be at **11:00am**

COURSE: Point-to-Point in and about Shelter Island Sound and Gardiner's Bay or Noyack & Little Peconic Bays. Sailing Instructions and scratch sheets will be available at the Breakwater Yacht Club on race day or on a race committee boat or on the Internet at www.breakwateryc.org prior to the race. A large course board on the starboard side of the race committee will be used to indicate each Division's course and starting order. The course will be an upwind start to marks described on the course board and to the finish at the Sag Harbor Breakwater.

DIVISIONS: Spinnaker, non-spinnaker, and one-design divisions (if sufficient boats enter to form any one design division).

SCORING: Scoring will be based on corrected times using the PHRF rating system in conjunction with the **time-on-time** methodology. $TCF = 650/(550 + PHRF)$.

AWARDS: Prizes will consist of bottles of a potent potable and will be awarded at the Breakwater Yacht Club clubhouse following the race. Refreshments will be offered. Any boat willing to bring munchies will be greatly appreciated.
