Notice of Race

RULES: This regatta will be governed by the **Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 edition**

ELIGIBILITY: All boats with a 2010 PHRF- ELI rating certificate and one design keel boats racing in their one design division are eligible.

START: In Noyac Bay -The start is between the RC boat (flying RC flag and yellow pennant) and a set mark at the most leeward point for prevailing wind conditions on day of race.

COURSE: Courses may be **Modified Olympic, Windward/leeward or Point to Point** depending on the division. The committee may start more than one race for Spinnaker Entries. One race will constitute a series. Instructions and scratch sheets will be available at the Breakwater Yacht Club or on a race committee boat or on the internet at www.breakwateryc.org or www.elisailing.org prior to the race. A large course board on the starboard side of the race committee will be used to indicate each Division's course and starting order. There will be a race for a bottle rum back to Sag Harbor for those going to the party by boat.

START TIME: The first gun (warning for first division to start) will be at **12:30 P.M. local time.**

SCORING: Scoring will be based on corrected times using the PHRF rating system and the **time-on-time** method. TCF (Time Correction Factor) = $650/(550 + \text{PHRF})$.

DIVISIONS: **Spinnaker, non- spinnaker and one- design divisions** (if sufficient boats enter to form a one design division).

ENTRY FEE: **\$100.00.** Deduct \$5.00 if a member of US Sailing and \$10.00 if a 2010 PHRF- ELI certificate is submitted with entry. Entries must be submitted to Carol Morse at 421 North Main Street, Southampton, New York 11968 and received by 5pm on Wednesday, August 11th. Entries must be complete with a valid 2010 PHRF-ELI certificate, a check made out to Breakwater Yacht Club, a completed race entry form with a signed waiver in order for your boat to be entered. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Race Committee.

AWARDS: Prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place generously donated by Atlantis Weather Gear in each division as well as the Sag Harbor Cup perpetual trophies for nonspinnaker, spinnaker, and One Design will be awarded. 1st Place: G3 Jacket, 2nd Place: G3 Vest, 3rd Place: Tech T. **There will be a party at the Breakwater Yacht Club following the regatta (captains meal included with entry; crew and other guests are \$15.00 each).**

MISSION: The net proceeds from this regatta are dedicated to the Breakwater Junior Sailing Program. A Tax-deductible donation of \$50.00 is included in your entry.
