SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. The International Yacht Racing Rules 2009-2012 edition and the General Conditions of the Eastern Long Island Sailing Association will govern the Regatta. US Sailing Racing Rule 52 is modified so that a Brenta 38 may use hydraulics for their mainsail only.
2. Changes or additions to these sailing instructions will be available from a **RC BOAT**, which will be in **Noyack Bay**, and monitoring **Channel 72**.
3. **STARTING SCHEDULE:** See **Course Board** on **Starboard side of RC boat** for all course information. The following schedule is the **probable** starting order but you must refer to the **flags** for the final order of start.

ALL DIVISIONS:

1st WARNING will be at 1230hrs

CRUISING CANVAS - code flag #2

Postponement

PHRF SPINNAKER - code flag #1

One-design J-109 - code flag #3

One-design J-105 -code flag #4

A code flag **1 through 4** will be raised at each Division's **WARNING**. All yachts not starting are required to keep clear of the starting area until your **WARNING** signal is made. The AP will be raised after the start of the Cruising Boats. The Spinnaker boats will have their starts at 5-minute intervals.

4. **START:** The starting area will be at the leeward end of **NOYACK BAY**, depending on wind conditions. The starting line will be between a yellow pennant on the **RC BOAT** and the ball at the port end of the line.
 - 4.1. A stand off buoy may be placed astern of the **RC BOAT**. This buoy will be considered a part of the boat. Yachts shall not pass between the buoy and the **RC BOAT**.
 - 4.2. The course to be sailed and approximate bearing and range to the **windward mark** will be displayed on a course board on the **starboard side of the RC BOAT**.
 - 4.3. A yacht shall not start later than five minutes after her starting signal.

CRUISING BOAT COURSES:

The windward or "W" for cruising boats will be partially up the course from the "W/O" mark for the spinnaker boats. The offset or "O" will be small ball.
