2 RULES

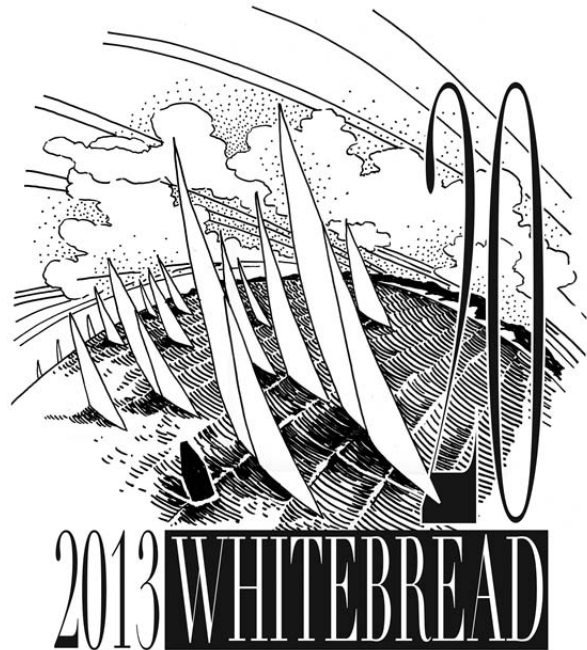
Whitebread 20 will be governed by The 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). If there is a conflict between Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Boats must meet the following requirements to be eligible to race:

- Monohull or Multihull sailing vessel of 22' LOA or greater and with an ELI/PHRF rating of 300 or less.
- Entry will be COMPLETE if the following 3 items are received by the published deadlines.

1. Entry fee: Payable on-line at www.pbsa.us or by check (PBSA, POB 1196 Cutchogue, NY 11935)
2. Completed Entry Form: Submitted on-line at www.pbsa.us, by email (Mindy@pbsa.us), by fax (631-204-6603) or by mail (PBSA, POB 1196 Cutchogue, NY 11935).
3. A valid rating certificate from PHRF of ELI, or a completed Temporary Day Rating Application submitted by email, fax or mail. **(If you hold a VALID 2013 ELI PHRF Certificate you do NOT need to send us a copy. We have it on file.)**



Entry Deadlines:

Monday, September 16, 2013	Open entry period for all boats ends. On-line entries and mailed applications postmarked after this date must add \$50.00 surcharge. Enter on-line at www.pbsa.us
Monday, September 30, 2013	Late Entry Postmark Deadline. Sorry, Absolutely No Exceptions! Accordingly, you are strongly urged to submit your COMPLETE application in a timely manner.
Wednesday, October 2, 2013	Last day to order gear. On-line gear ordering ends. Mailed gear orders received that are postmarked after this date will be returned. Order on-line at www.pbsa.us
Wednesday, October 2, 2013	Entry Deadline for On-line and hand delivered entries. Completed application and entry fee must be in the hands of the Race Committee by this date. Mailed entries postmarked after the Late Entry Postmark Deadline will be returned. Enter on-line at www.pbsa.us
Wednesday, October 2, 2013	Division Change Deadline Changes between Spinnaker Division and Non-Spinnaker Division will not be permitted after this date.

4 DIVISION SPLITS:

All efforts will be made to provide division splits designed to improve competition. The race committee will also use criteria other than ratings to decide division splits.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS/RACE PACKETS

Sailing Instructions will be posted at www.pbsa.us in early September. Race Packets will include a backstay division flag, sailing instructions and scratch sheet and will be available at the Friday night Pre-Race Party/Skipper’s Meeting. Division flags must be flown from the backstay (preferably) or the stern of competing sailing vessels. Participants are strongly encouraged to attend the Pre-Race Party/Skipper’s Meeting or arrange for a fellow competitor to pick up their Race packet. Packets may be available Saturday morning on the water via support boat.

8 THE COURSE

The course for each Division will be selected by the Race Committee from the list of courses contained in the Sailing Instructions. All courses start in New Suffolk and circumnavigate Shelter Island. Course lengths vary between 25 and 31 miles.
