## 2 RULES

Whitebread 20 will be governed by The 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). If there is a conflict between Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall apply.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Boats must meet the following requirements to be eligible to race:

- Monohull or Multihull sailing vessel of 22'
   LOA or greater and with an ELI/PHRF
   rating of 300 or less.
- Entry will be COMPLETE if the following 3
  items are received by the published
  deadlines.

- 3. A valid rating certificate from PHRF of ELI, or a completed Temporary Day Rating Application submitted by email, fax or mail. (If you hold a VALID 2013 ELI PHRF Certificate you do NOT need to send us a copy. We have it on file.)

#### 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS/RACE PACKETS

Race Packets will include a backstay division flag, sailing instructions and scratch sheet and will be available at the Friday night Pre-Race Party/Skipper's Meeting. Division flags must be flown from the backstay (preferably) or the stern of competing sailing vessels.
