## Notice of Race ALOHA SUMMER The Last 'R.O.T.S.'

(Race Of The Season)

<u>RULES:</u> This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 edition. US Sailing Racing Rule 52 is modified so that a Brenta 38 may use hydraulics for their mainsail only.

<u>ELIGIBILITY:</u> All boats with a 2014 PHRF- ELI rating certificate and one design keelboats racing in their one design division are eligible. This race will not count toward any Breakwater or ELIYA series.

ENTRY FEE: \$30.00. The only deduction will be \$5.00 if a member of US Sailing. Entries must be complete with payment made on the BYC website (<a href="www.breakwateryc.org/racing/phrf">www.breakwateryc.org/racing/phrf</a>) or a check made out to "Breakwater Yacht Club", a valid 2014 ELI-PHRF certificate, and the completed & signed race entry form submitted to Sean Elliott, Sailing Director at BYC clubhouse; Mail: BYC, P.O. **START:** In Sag Harbor-The start is between the RC boat (flying RC flag and yellow pennant) and a set mark at the most leeward point of Shelter Island Sound

START TIME: The first gun (warning for first division to start) will be at 11:00am

<u>COURSE:</u> Point-to-Point in and about Shelter Island Sound and Gardiner's Bay or Noyack & Little Peconic Bays. Sailing Instructions and scratch sheets will be available at the Breakwater Yacht Club on race day or on a race committee boat prior to the race. A large course board on the starboard side of the race committee will be used to indicate each Division's course and starting order. The course will be an upwind start to marks described on the course board and to the finish at the Sag Harbor Breakwater.

<u>DIVISIONS:</u> Spinnaker, non-spinnaker, and one-design divisions (if sufficient boats enter to form any one design division).

**SCORING:** Scoring will be based on corrected times using the PHRF rating system in conjunction with the **time-on-time** methodology. TCF = 600/(480+ PHRF).

**AWARDS:** Prizes will consist of bottles of a potent potable and will be awarded at the Breakwater Yacht Club clubhouse following the race. Refreshments will be offered. Any boat willing to bring munchies will be greatly appreciated.
