> NOTICE OF RACE Heatherton Trophy Race Sunday, July 6, 2014

Organizing Authority: The Shelter Island Yacht Club.

1. Rules: The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, (RRS) 2013-2016, and the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, except as changed by this notice, the ELIYA General Conditions and the 2014 Heatherton Trophy Race Sailing Instructions.

2. Classes: The Race is open to all PHRF class boats with a **current**, **2014**, PHRF-ELI Certificate, and that can demonstrate compliance with all requirements of the certificate. There will be both spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes, divided in accordance with the 2014 Heatherton Trophy Race Sailing Instructions.

Entrants are encouraged to display the code flag for their division from the backstay to facilitate identification by other entrants and the Race Committee.

Note: If at least three boats of a one design class enter to race, using the class one design rating, they will be scored as a class as well as within the appropriate division, e.g., J105s racing as a class as well as in division I.

3. Scoring: PHRF, Time on Time Scoring.

4. Start Times: (See RRS, Part 3, 26 Starting Races)

<u>Signal</u>	Flag and Sound Minutes I	<u>pefore start</u>
Warning	Class Flag + 1 sound	5
Preparatory	P,I,Z, Z+ I, or Black flag(s), +1 Sound	4
One-minute	Preparatory Flag removed: 1 long sound	1
Starting	Class flag removed: 1 Sound	0

The first **warning signal** will be at **1300**. The warning signal for subsequent classes shall be made **with or after** the starting signal of the preceding class.

5. The Start: Between an Orange Flag on the Race Committee Boat and a red ball or an inflatable mark set in Gardiners Bay approximately 1.5 NM SSE, bearing 165 M, of <u>RW "N" Mo(A) WHIS</u>.

6. The Finish: Between an Orange Flag on the Race Committee Boat and a red ball, an inflatable mark or Government mark set in the location indicated under courses in the Sailing Instructions.

7. Courses: Courses in detail will be included in the Sailing Instructions. From the start the courses will be in Gardiners Bay and may finish in Pipes Cove. However, the Race Committee may elect to provide a different course for **all or some** divisions.

8. Sailing Instructions: The Sailing Instructions will be available at the Shelter Island YC one week prior to the race, on <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>, or from the Committee Boat on the day of the race.

9. Communications: The Race Committee will monitor Channels 72.

10 Time Limit: Five hours from the start time for **each** division.

11. Entries: Entry fee: \$50.00.

Entries **<u>must</u>** be made on <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>. Please complete the entry carefully and do not neglect to indicate in which Division you intend to race and to sign the waiver.

A copy of the boat's 2014 PHRF-ELI certificate must be received by the race committee before an entry will be considered final.

12 Entries: Entries must be made by Monday, June 30, 2014.
