1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

1.1 Breakwater Yacht Club

2. RULES

2.1 Racing will be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The Sag Harbor Cup is open to sailboats with a valid 2014 ELI-PHRF Certificate

3.2 To get an ELI-PHRF Certificate go to www.elisailing.org and follow the links on the right hand column.

5. ENTRY FEES – Due by 8pm on Thursday, July 17th, 2014.

5.1 \$100.00 entry fee includes 2 wristbands for party (\$50 Tax deductible). Additional bands will be available for \$20.00. Entry form & fees must be mailed to Sailing Director, PO Box 2601, Sag Harbor, NY 11963, or placed in the RC box in the BYC office. Forms and PHRF Certificates can also be emailed to Sailingdirector@BreakwaterYC.org or RC@BreakwaterYC.org and must be received by 8pm on Thursday, July 17th, 2014. All entries must include a check made out to Breakwater Yacht Club, a completed ELIYA race entry form with the signed waiver in order for your boat to be entered.

5.4 The Race Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.

6. THE COURSE

The race is an around Island race either clockwise or counter-clockwise around Plum Island from the southwest corner of Gardiner's Bay. Race committee reserves the right to shorten course.

6.1 The race will **START** in the southwestern part of Gardiner's Bay.

6.2 The **FINISH** will be between the Race Committee Boat and RW"N" Mo (A) in Gardiner's Bay.

7. SCORING

7.1 All classes will be scored using time on time.

8. PRIZES

8.1 Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third in all divisions with at least 4 boats entered.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be emailed to all entrants by Thursday 7/17, and will be available from the Race Committee Boat prior to the regatta, and may be available at www.elisailing.org or www.breakwateryc.org. All qualified entrants will be notified by email of any changes to the Sailing Instructions by 6pm prior to the day of the race, otherwise will be notified by the Race Committee Boat on the day of the Race
